GORDON CAMPAIGN CRITICIZES PARTISANSHIP IN RULE CHANGE

DENVER, CO—“It is disturbing to see that the rules have been changed midstream to gain a partisan advantage. Colorado needs a Secretary of State who is fair, impartial, and above partisan political pressure,” said Campaign Manager Zach Zaslow, in response to the August 24 report in the *Denver Post* that Secretary of State Gigi Dennis rewrote campaign-finance rules with language proposed by two Republican lawyers, both of whom counsel Republican candidates and political committees.

Added Zaslow: “If elected, Ken Gordon will act on this issue, and every other, with independence and impartiality.” Senate Majority Leader Ken Gordon has never taken a single dollar of special interest PAC money. Since his first campaign for the State House in 1992, he has not accepted donations from small-donor committees or other PACs.

Senator Gordon is the Democratic candidate for Secretary of State.
